Dr. Chacon says this powder is a top recommendation of hers, and she uses it as well. "It's not only an affordable option but is also praised for its high-quality collagen content, which can support skin health. It's hydrolyzed for maximum absorption and effectiveness," she says. Dr. Chacon adds, "It's easy to incorporate into your daily routine, as it can be added to drinks or food."

Miami dermatologist Dr. Deborah Longwill recommends this powder supplement that features nine essential amino acids, tons of collagen and a powerful combination of biotin and vitamin C to promote healthy skin, hair, nails and joints.



Bend Marine Collagen + Co-Factors Powder (\$47)

New York dermatologist Dr. Anetta Reszko says Bend Collagen is the favorite at her practice, and they often recommend it to patients. "It's a hydrolyzed wild-caught marine collagen paired with co-factors of vitamin C and silicon, which are essential for collagen cross-linking to form strong and resilient collagen," she explains. "The vitamin C component also provides antioxidant properties to protect the skin from environmental free radicals."

"Wearing a broad-spectrum sunscreen every single day is one of the best things you can do to stop the degradation of existing collagen while helping to protect the new cells being constantly produced in the skin," says Dr. Schlessinger. "I love this one from Colorescience because it contains all mineral sunscreen filters with 10 percent zinc oxide, is reef safe and blends into most skin tones with virtually no white cast."

Simply Serum Collagen Complex (\$160)
